SHEPHERD TALK

Walking with God

When you walk with the Lord, your will is going to align with His will, and since you are walking hand in hand with Him, your focus will be on Him and His will. When you are walking daily with someone you are going to understand them better than you ever did. You are going to know their heart. Walking with God is not just a short time in prayer with Him, it is a lifestyle, a relationship that we can only obtain through Jesus Christ our Lord.

1 John 5:13-21 Tells us we can know we have eternal life. Here is an easy test to see if we are walking with God. First: The Lordship Test. Is Jesus Christ the Lord of your life 1 John 2:3 Tells us "we know that we have come to know Him if we obey His commands". Is keeping His commandments the burning desire of our heart? It is if we have met the Christ of Calvary. Next: The Fellowship Test. Do we love our brothers and sisters in Christ? 1 John 4:7-12 Tells us that "God is Love" and that we should love one another, "if we love one another, God lives in us and His love is made complete in us". Lastly: The Relationship Test. The question is not, "Did you believe in Jesus Christ? The question is, rather, Are you believing in Jesus right now? 1 John 5: 12 "He who has the Son has life, he who does not have the Son of God does not have life." Are we daily seeking that hand in hand relationship with God and His Son? Are we seeking to put God first in our lives, are we loving one another, if we are walking daily with God, we can know we are in a saved relationship because God is Love. 1 Corinthians 13:4-13 Love never fails.
