Who are the Covenant People of God? Vv. 1-3

v.3 " worship in the Spirit of God and glory in Christ Jesus and put no confidence in the flesh"

Trusting in the "Good" Life. Vv. 4-6 (Paul has solid credentials for legal self-rightness.)

Glorying in Christ Jesus! Vv. 7-11 (Everything is Changed when one Chooses to GLORY in CHRIST rather than SELF!)

Take Home:

Glorying in Christ is the giving up of all personal attainment and trusting in what He does!

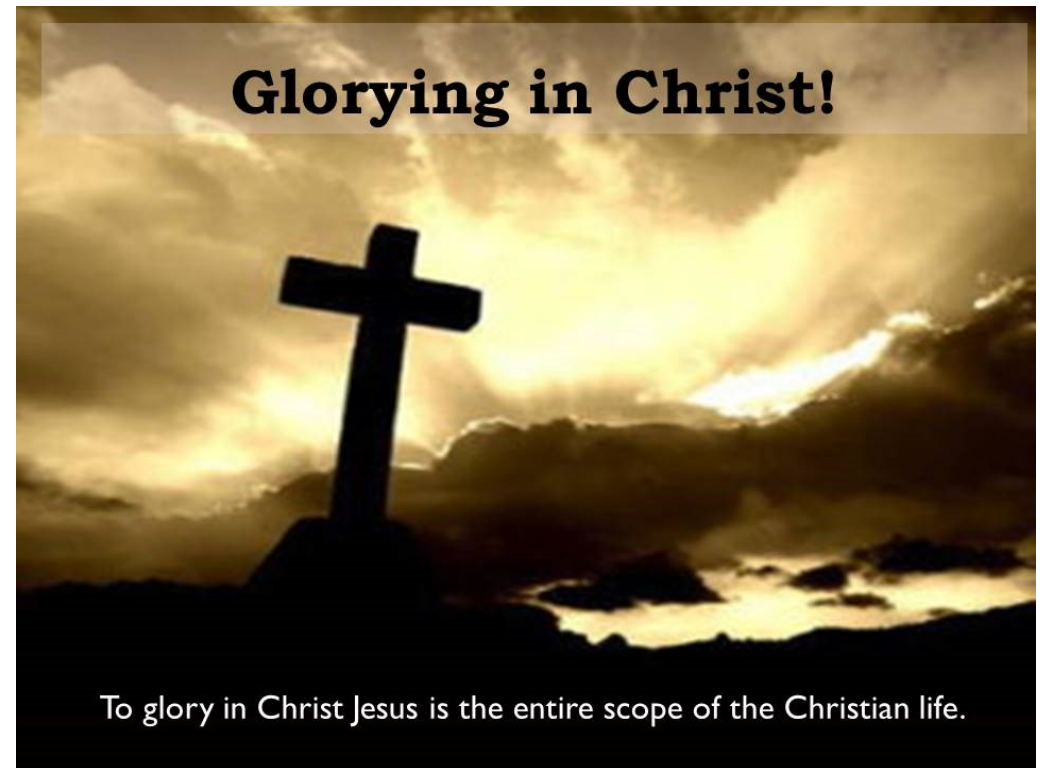
