SHEPHERD TALK

Counterfeits

Experts in counterfeit money will tell you that spotting a counterfeit requires knowing the real thing intimately. They spend years studying currency, usually in the form of paper money. They know a real \$100 bill down to the smallest line and the finest detail. When something is not right in the look, or in the feel, or sometimes even in the sound of a piece of money, an expert knows it's a counterfeit. They have spent enough time with the original, that they can sense a fake with just a quick look most of the time.

Imagine if your only experience with money was that you had a single, one dollar bill. That was the only money you had ever seen or touched. Would you be able to spot a fake? Every piece of money that had a different number in the corner like a 5, 10, or 20, would look to you like a counterfeit. Other bills with a one in the corners, but a different serial number would be fake. Wrinkles or folds would probably seem okay because your bill could be wrinkled or folded. But any other difference would make other bills look counterfeit to you.

Chapters 13 and 14 of the gospel of John give us information about how to spot a counterfeit in God's kingdom, and how to know the real deal when you see it. Christ says, "Anyone who has seen me, has seen the Father." And also, "Your love for one another will prove to the world that you are my disciples." Being able to spot a counterfeit is only possible if you have intimate knowledge of the real thing. If you don't study it close enough, everything will look like it's real. If you focus too closely on a single detail, everything will look like a counterfeit.
