## HALLMARKS

### To Be Truly Healed...

Jesus stands in a crowded room and begins to teach. As He talks, five men try to find their way into the room, but it is too crowded. Standing outside, they begin to devise a plan to get to Jesus. The five men, with some difficulty, relocate to the roof and begin to dig. Once they have burrowed through the roof, they look over to their friend, who is paralyzed and unable to walk. He is the reason for their caper. They fix ropes around him and his mat and carefully lower him through the freshly dug hole. He descends to the floor and comes to rest at the feet of Jesus. Jesus, without missing a beat, (in what had to be a bizarre scene) looks up at the hole and then down at the paralyzed man. Jesus sees the men's faith and He sees a man in great need. The room grows quiet to see how Jesus will respond. Jesus speaks into the stillness and heals the greatest need of the man when He says the words, "**Son, your sins are forgiven.**" Some people in the room were offended that Jesus would dare offer this forgiveness. Knowing their hearts, Jesus demonstrates his authority to forgive sins by proving He also has dominion over the created world by healing the legs of the paralytic. The once-paralyzed man takes his mat and exits the room. Everyone was amazed at the things they had witnessed and said, "We have never seen anything like this!" (paraphrase of Mark 2:1-12)

God has done much for me, but the greatest thing he has done in my life is to offer me the forgiveness of my sins through the blood of His only son. My greatest comfort comes from the fact that the Lord over all creation calls me son, forgives my sins, and showers me with undeserved grace and mercy!
